**STATEMENT BY RAIM ON AFRIFORUM'S MISINFORMATION CAMPAIGN AND
TREASONOUS CONDUCT AGAINST SOUTH AFRICA AND THE WORKING CLASS**

1. The Danger of AfriForum's Misinformation and Its Global Consequences

Public Service and Commercial Union (PSCU) strongly condemns AfriForum's ongoing campaign of deceit and misrepresentation regarding the Expropriation Act passed by the South African government. AfriForum, under the guise of "minority rights advocacy," has engaged in a deliberate misinformation campaign that has not only misled the United States government and the global community but has actively worked against the sovereignty and economic justice of South Africa's Black majority.

By falsely portraying the Expropriation Act as a mechanism for racial persecution rather than a legitimate means to address historical land dispossession, AfriForum has provided ammunition to international forces seeking to destabilize South Africa. Their lies have directly contributed to foreign hostility toward our government, including the unjustified suspension of critical humanitarian aid that millions of South Africans rely on for basic survival.

AfriForum's actions align with the broader white supremacist agenda of the West, which has long sought to maintain control over Africa's resources while ensuring that Black people remain landless, powerless, and economically dependent. Their partnership with Trump-era policies and other anti-African forces is nothing short of treasonous.

2. AfriForum's Role in Undermining South Africa's Sovereignty

AfriForum's history of lobbying foreign governments against South Africa is not new. They have actively:

- Defended apartheid and colonial-era privileges while undermining Black economic empowerment policies;
- Pushed the false narrative of "white genocide" to justify foreign intervention;
- Called for international action against South Africa based on outright lies;
- Exploited state weaknesses to position themselves as an alternative governance structure while maintaining white economic dominance.

This is a direct attack on South Africa's sovereignty, designed to create conditions for international economic sanctions and foreign intervention—just as we have seen in other African nations where the West has sought to control and destabilize governments that challenge white hegemony.

3. Legal Violations and the Need for Accountability

AfriForum's conduct is not just immoral; it is unlawful under both South African and international law. Their actions may constitute:

- Treason under South African law (Section 16 of the Riotous Assemblies Act, 1956), as they are actively working with foreign powers to undermine the state.
- Contravention of the Promotion of Equality and Prevention of Unfair Discrimination Act (PEPUDA), as their actions deliberately fuel racial tension and promote white supremacist propaganda.
- Violation of the UN Charter (Article 2), which prohibits actions that seek to interfere in the sovereignty of independent nations through misinformation and political lobbying.
- Breach of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights (ICCPR), which protects nations from deliberate destabilization efforts by hostile groups.

4. Immediate Actions Required Against AfriForum

In light of AfriForum's blatant betrayal of the country, **Public Service and Commercial Union of South Africa (PSCU)** demands the following:

1. The South African government must classify AfriForum's lobbying of foreign governments as treason and take immediate legal action against its leadership.
2. A full investigation into AfriForum's funding sources must be conducted, exposing their international backers who seek to undermine South Africa's sovereignty.
3. Immediate legislative amendments must be introduced to prevent anti-Black, anti-state organizations from colluding with foreign powers to weaken our nation.
4. South African diplomatic missions worldwide must actively counter AfriForum's propaganda and engage with international partners to ensure the truth about the Expropriation Act is properly understood.
5. Progressive Black and White organizations must unite globally to challenge white supremacist misinformation and defend the economic and political liberation of Black people.
6. A Call for national unity and Vigilance

South Africans must wake up to the reality that organizations like AfriForum are not merely interest groups—they are agents of neocolonial control, working hand in hand with imperialist powers to keep us in economic bondage. Their objective is clear: to maintain white privilege and obstruct black liberation, regardless of the cost to the millions of South Africans who suffer under the economic legacies of apartheid.

We must reject their lies with absolute clarity and expose their true intentions at every turn. AfriForum and its allies are not interested in facts, law, or justice. They are the foot soldiers of a global white supremacist agenda that must be confronted with equal determination.

Down with white supremacy!
Down with neocolonial treachery!
Forward with Black economic justice and sovereignty!
